Theme

We invite submissions on all topics related to Dispute Resolution Mechanisms including Arbitration, Mediation, Conciliation, Negotiation etc.

Deadline for Submission

All entries must be submitted by April 25, 2021

Submission Guidelines

Submissions can be made under the following heads:

1. **Long Articles**– Word limit of 6000 words.
2. **Short Articles**– Word Limit of 4000 to 4500 words.
3. **Case Comments**– Word Limit of 1500 to 2000 words.
4. **Book Reviews** – Word limit of 2000 to 2500 words

The word limit is exclusive of footnotes

Format of Submission

All the contributors must adhere to the following guidelines:

1. All Submissions shall be in English only.
2. All Submissions must be accompanied by an abstract not exceeding 300 words.
3. The body of the document must be in Times New Roman with a font size of 12 and Line Spacing of 1.5 with justified alignment.
4. All the footnotes should be in Times New Roman, Font Size 10 and with single line spacing.
5. The citations must conform to The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation (20th Edition.)
6. Co-authorship is permissible up to a maximum of two authors.
7. All submissions are required to be mailed in .doc/.docx format only.
8. The copyright over the manuscripts vest with the CADR, however, all the moral rights vest with the author. At no time will CADR use the submission for commercial use without notice to the author(s) or without attributing to them.

Submissions which do not adhere to the guidelines provided shall not be considered for review. All the submissions must be mailed only to **submissions.cadr@rgnul.ac.in** with a cover letter specifying the following:
