ABOUT THE ORGANIZER

National Law University (NLU), Delhi is a premier institution, imparting legal education in India, established in 2008 with the objective of promoting cultural, legal and ethical values with a view to promote and foster the rule of law and the objectives enshrined in the Constitution of India. Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law (RGNUL), Punjab, was established by the State Legislature of Punjab by passing the Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law Punjab Act, (Punjab Act No. 12 of 2006). NLU Delhi and RGNUL, Punjab are elite national law schools in India to protect and promote the multidisciplinary, cross-border best practices in global legal education.

The University of Campania “Luigi Vanvitelli” Naples is an Italian Research University founded in late 1991. Its main seat is in Caserta, but its academic departments are also located in a series of historic and contemporary buildings in Naples, Aversa, Capua and Santa Maria Capua Vetere.

The Himachal Pradesh National Law University, Shimla (HPNLU, Shimla), was established by the State Government in the year 2016, by an Act of the Legislature (Act 16 of 2016). The University started functioning from 5th of October 2016.

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

The Post-Graduate Winter School is an intensive collaboratively designed one-week academic program that brings together prominent scholars, young academicians and students from across the world. The Patiala Post Graduate Winter School is a fourth edition in the series. The earlier editions were organised by the University of Campania “Luigi Venvitali” Napels (Italy) and NLU, New Delhi (India). The Patiala Post Graduate Winter School is split into two parts. The participant from abroad would assemble at NLU, New Delhi and the first day programme of the Winter School would be conducted there. For the rest of days RGNUL Punjab would host the programme at its campus at Patiala. The programme aims at promoting international goodwill and cross-cultural dialogue amongst promising young individuals, developing their potential as future leaders in government, business and civil society; with India as a study model. The programme offers post graduate as well as undergraduate course modules and experiences which introduce the yougn academicians and students to a range of issues & debates that are shaping contemporary developing societies.

CALL FOR PAPERS

Research papers are invited from the academicians, scholars, researchers, practitioners and students on the emerging issues and related areas. It is proposed that the selected research papers will be published in a special volume in the form of an edited book with a renowned publisher.

GUIDELINES FOR THE PAPER

The abstract of the paper should contain 250 – 350 words accompanied by a brief profile of the author indicating his/her email ID, contact number and official address.

Paper should not be of more than 7000 words. It must be typed in Times New Roman Font Size 12 on A4 size paper with 1” margin on all sides with 1.5 line spacing using MS Word application. The Blue Book: A Uniform system of Citation (19th ed.) should be followed.

SUBMISSION DEADLINES

Abstract & Paper Submission: Soft copy of the full paper along with the abstract shall be submitted via e-mail to winterschool@rgnul.ac.in on or before last dates, specifying ‘Winter School Paper’ in subject of the mail. A hard copy of the single side printed full paper must be submitted a week before the commencement of the programme.
