

 Ministry of Education, Government of India has recently launched the scheme of Academic Bank of Credits (ABC), with the aim to enable students mobility across Higher Education Institution, seamless, integration of skills and experiences into a Credit Based System. It has been established on the lines of National Academic Depository (NAD). ABC enables students to register or commence credit transfer, the final outcomes of credit redemption and issuance of certificates, as well as the compilation of awards records are administered by academic institutions. There is a need for: 1. Committee to understand the nuances (senior faculty member and exam branch training for ABC). 2. A detailed document on steps needed to initiate the process; highlight it on the website and prospectus and how to make it functional for the present batches of the students. 	apprised that the RGNUL has already registered for the Academic Bank of Credits, on the Government Portal.  To apprise the members that the RGNUL in order to promote and incentivise quality publications as initiated grants: a) Rs. 21000/- to faculty members for a research paper published in a journal which is indexed in Scopus or Web of Science or ICI Grant (restriction to one paper per annum per faculty members). Financial grant of up to Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Lakh) for research proposal on the recommendations of external evaluators to faculty members to meet expenses on equipment, books and journals, contingency, consumables, travel and field work and any other special requirements for promotion of quality research. Maximum of three cases of research grant shall be chosen every year in accordance with the recommendations of a committee constituted by the worthy Vice-Chancellor. Suitable norms for this will be devised. A faculty member who has received the grant under the scheme will become eligible of the next year grant only after the submission and approval of the project report. The RGNUL alumnus has been doing very well. We have number of students as Officers, JAG Officers, Army Officers, Judicial Officers, Assistant Professors, Corporate Lawyers and Bureaucrats. Recently Mr. Athenam Velan the Alumni of RGNUL, Punjab who graduated in 2012, has established its start-up named "Law Maitri Pvt. Ltd." Law Maitri has prepared the acceptable model of course curriculum for schools level students and is expected to achieve its objective. They are offering course titled "TEEN LL.B." imparting basic legal education to school children (<u>ANNEXURE-7</u>). Further, Mr. Anmol Malhota, the alumni of RGNUL (Batch 2020). He is working on a start-up called "Newsahoot". They provide jargon and negativity-free news specially written for children between 8-15 years, they believe reading about real-world events makes kids more insightful and empathetic. Some examples of news they have covered include (a) the global silicon shortage; (b) the closing of the ozone hole; and (c) the Russia-Ukraine conflict.
