Virtual Inspection of RGNUL by Bar Council of India 10^{th} February 2023

The Law Undergraduate Degree courses are required to be approved by the Bar Council of India. The approval is granted for a fixed period. The B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) Course at RGNUL has been granted approval by the Bar Council of India till academic year 2022-23. The renewal of the approval was due in 2023-24. Accordingly, University applied for renewal of the approval of the Bar Council of India. Further, there was a proposal from RGNUL to increase the number of seats by one additional unit *i.e.*, 60 students. The extension of seats also requires the approval of the Bar Council of India.

RGNUL, therefore, filed an application for renewal of approval and for extension of seats by 60. The application was processed by the Bar Council of India. After processing of the application, an inspection is carried out by the Bar Council of India. On 10th February 2023, the Bar Council of India conducted virtual inspection of the University.

The Vice-Chancellor of Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab Prof. (Dr.) G.S. Bajpai introduced the University and presented an overview of the Academic and Physical Infrastructure of the University. Prof. (Dr.) G.S. Bajpai briefed the team of experts from BCI regarding the vision and mission of the University and the future plan of the University.

The team consisting of five experts from Bar Council of India conducted the virtual inspection of the physical infrastructure at RGNUL, *i.e.*, Classrooms, Moot Court Room, Lecture Halls, Auditorium, Administrative Block, University Entrance, Common Rooms, Seminar Hall etc. The team conducted inspection of the University infrastructure and asked relevant questions from the RGNUL team. Team of the Bar Council of India also conducted virtual interaction with the faculty members of the RGNUL.

After faculty interaction, Vice Chancellor, Professor (Dr.) G.S. Bajpai gave the concluding remarks and answered the queries of the BCI team to their full satisfaction. Prof. (Dr.) Anand Pawar, Registrar and Prof. (Dr.) Naresh Vats, Dean Academic Affairs steered the BCI inspection process.
