The programme have daily sessions from 9:30AM to 6:00 PM. The Training Programme was organised in view of the enactment of the Mediation Act 2023 and in recognition that Law Universities play a critical role in developing future mediation professionals. The Programme was designed to enhance faculty competence and ensure academic alignment with National Mediation standards and MCPC's Vision.
