SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

1. Eligibility:

We invite students from undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral qualifications, practitioners, academicians, policymakers, and scholars to participate in our conference to share valuable insights on the subject and start a dialogue on issues not discussed before.

2. Abstracts:

Abstracts shall be within the range of 300-350 words, with a minimum of 5 keywords (not counted in the word limit). The Abstracts can be submitted at: conferencecorporatelaw@gmail.com

3. Word Limit Papers shall be in the length of 3000-5000 words. Detailed guidelines are as follows:

i. Author(s) should not mention their personal details at any places in the manuscript. Personal Details and Institutional Affiliations should be mentioned in a separate cover letter.

ii. The Cover Letter should have the Following Details:

- Name of all the Authors
- Email Address of all the Authors
- Contact Details of all the Authors
- Designation of all the Authors
- Institute Name of all the Authors
- Title of the Paper

iii. The main body text in the manuscript must be in Times New Roman in a font size of 12, 1.5 line spacing and in justified alignment. For footnotes, maintain Times New Roman Style with a font size of 10 and 1.0 line spacing. For Headings, Times New Roman style must be followed with a font size of 14 and must be Bold and Underlined.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- iv. Abstracts and cover letters are to be emailed in .doc or .docx format only.
- v. Participants are requested to only submit their Abstract initially.
- vi. Participants should follow the Bluebook 20th Edition for the purpose of Citing the footnotes

4.Co- authorship:

Co-authors up to 3 shall be permitted. However, the registration fee will be charged per individual and not per abstract/paper.

5.Paper presentation:

The participants whose Abstracts are selected shall be allowed to present their ideas in a 10-minute presentation before a panel.

6.Book Release:

All the selected papers shall be published in a book as a Conference Proceedings. The Book shall be bearing an ISBN Number
