The event, themed "*Ideas worth Spreading*," witnessed thought-provoking talks on courage, resilience, innovation, and social responsibility, leaving the audience inspired and motivated.

Justice Swarna Kanta Sharma shared her inspiring journey, highlighting the discrimination and social persecution women often face in society. She emphasized the
