The seminar was held in collaboration with Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) North-Western Regional Centre, Panjab University and Manupatra. Former acting chief justice of Himachal Pradesh High Court Sabina and former judge of Rajasthan and Punjab and Haryana High Court were the chief guests for the inaugural session. A total of 141 papers were presented by the participants from India and abroad in the conference. Dilip Ukey, Vice-Chancellor (VC), Maharashtra National Law University, Mumbai, was the guest of honour. Anand Pawar, officiating VC, RGNUL emphasised on enhancing access to justice, and promoting human rights and fundamental freedom for all in the welcome address.
