## Agahi 2014 Adjudicator Subsidy Rules:

These rules will be hereby referred to as the RGNUL adjudicator subsidy rules and must be conformed to whilst providing subsidy to any adjudicator for this very edition of the Agahi.

- 1. For the purpose of the rules the following shall mean:
  - a. *Independent adjudicator*: The adjudicator shall not be a part of any competing team or be coming through the 'n+1' formulae.
  - b. Website: Shall mean the designated website for the Agahi '14 competition.
  - c. Subsidy: See clause 6 for the same.
- 2. For the purposes of subsidy it is required that independent adjudicators apply in the weblink in the relevant form for consideration
- 3. The application must have relevant adjudicating and debating credentials along.
- 4. The adjudicators with the maximum marks will be considered for given subsidy.
- 5. The marking criteria for judging the score of each applicant will be as follows:
  - a. Best adjudicator: 10 points
  - b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Best Adjudicator: 7 points
  - c. Breaking adjudicator: 5 points
  - d. Best team: 7 points
  - e. Best speaker: 5 points
  - f. Runners Up team: 3 points
  - g. 2<sup>nd</sup> best speaker:3 points
- 6. The total points for each candidate shall be the addition of points earned through every achievement.
- 7. The subsidy shall be consisting of the following:
  - a. Waiver of registration fees
  - b. Travel Allowance from Delhi to Patiala (Bus communication)
- 8. Candidates will be required to present a true / copy of the ticket they used for traveling.
- 9. Deadline for application: 20 August 2014
  - 10. Successful candidates will be selected by: Agahi Core Committee
