ABOUT RGNUL

The Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law (RGNUL), Punjab, was established by the State Legislature of Punjab by the Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab Act, 2006. The University acquired approval of the Bar Council of India (BCI) in July 2006 and got registered with the University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi. University was accredited with 'A' Grade by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2015. The spacious campus of RGNUL at Sidhuwal, Bhadson Road, Patiala spans an area of 50 Acres of land. The University has set up seventeen centres of research with the objective to undertake advanced study and research in the emerging areas of the respective fields.
