The training programme is aimed at replenishing and updating the knowledge of the Law Officers of the National Investigation Agency in terms of the latest developments in the legal and technical landscape pertaining to Counter Terror Laws, Investigation and Prosecution. The training programme tries to initiate and further the debate not only on the counter-terror laws but also on the broader understanding of Terrorism Radicalisation. Over a period of five days, several sessions will be held on issues such as Collection of Evidence, Electronic Evidence and Social Media, Structured Investigation in Counter Terror Cases, Social Media and Online Radicalization, Latest Amendments and Latest Judgments under the UAPA, 1967 and NIA Act, 2008, Provisions for Investigation and Prosecution of Terror Related Offences under Criminal Laws, etc.

Sh. Atulchandra Kulkarni, Additional Director General, NIA was the Chief Guest for the Inaugural Session. While discussing the emergent issues relating to Terrorism, Sh.
