Judiciary Guidance by Alumna Anandita Bhargava

The institution organized a guidance session with Alumna Anandita Bhargava, who shared her experiences and preparation strategies for judicial services. Release of SANKALP

Career Counselling Sessions

During the year 2024–2025, around 400–500 students benefited from career counselling sessions organized by the institution. Competitive Exam Success
