**Prof. Simon Bronitt interacts with RGNUL Faculty  
11-12 January 2023**

Prof. Simon Bronitt, Dean, School of Law, the University of Sydney, Australia, Mr. Peter Finneran, and Ms. Vered, visited the Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab on 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> January, 2023. Prof. G.S. Bajpai, Vice-Chancellor, RGNUL welcomed distinguished academicians from the University of Sydney. Speaking on the occasion, Prof. Bajpai highlighted the vision and accomplishments of RGNUL. "The Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law (RGNUL), Punjab proffers exceptional and effective pedagogy to empower learners. In order to meet the dynamic demands of legal services, RGNUL has been introducing new initiatives not only to empower students but also to equip faculty with opportunities for professional development," he said. "The growing global economic, political integration and New Education Policy (NEP 2020) drive higher education institutions to think and act beyond national boundaries," observed Prof. Bajpai.

Professor Bronitt, an expert in Criminal Law, interacted with faculty members and introduced Sydney Law School (which is among the six sandstone universities in the country). He proposed to collaborate with Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab for conducting various programs including Faculty and Student Exchange Program, workshops and other activities to explore the methodologies and teaching pedagogies of both the countries. "Such exchange programs infuse international experience. The integration of intercultural aspects facilitates understanding and encourages people to broaden their experience as well as knowledge," said Prof. Bonitt. He encouraged the faculty to collaborate in the areas of Jurisprudence, Criminal Law, Literature, Economics, Victimology, International Humanitarian Law, Sociology, Taxation and Business Law, Intellectual Property Laws and Consumer Laws for research.

Prof. Anand Pawar, Registrar, RGNUL, while presenting concluding remarks, emphasized on the importance of creating awareness of international perceptions on campus through exchange programs. "Assimilation of global education and international experience in scholarship as well as teaching fills gaps and promotes excellence in education," he observed.
