The Executive Council deliberated on the matter at length and authorized the Vice-Chancellor to constitute a Committee to review the performance of probation period as per Regulations of the Teaching and Non-teaching staff who were appointed on regular basis by the RGNUL, Punjab.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
