IQAC had initiated the process of revision of getting the revision of curriculum from the outside experts. In the first phase, curriculum of social science major/minor papers had been revised in accordance with the guidance, suggestions and changes marked by the experts. In the second phase the curriculum of law subjects of B.A.LL.B. course (60 approx.) have been sent to outside experts which were expected to be received back before the commencement of the new session. The RGNUL Syllabus Review Committee met before every semester to review and revise the syllabus for the new Academic Session. For the Academic Session February - May 2019 the committee recommended to adopt the policy that the revised syllabus received from the outside experts for specific subjects be incorporated as revised syllabus and for other subjects of this even semester, the previously approved syllabus be considered to apply. However, after such an exhaustive exercise, which involved multiple experts from outside, there is a need to frame certain rules for revision of syllabus.	The RGNUL Syllabus Review Committee met before every semester to review and revise the syllabus for the coming Academic Session. For the Academic Session February - May 2019 the committee recommended to adopt the policy that the revised syllabus received from the outside experts for specific subjects be incorporated as revised syllabus and for other subjects of this even semester, the previously approved syllabus be considered to apply.
