RGNUL COVID-19 Committee

Meeting of the RGNUL COVID-19 Committee was called to discuss issues related to examination schedule, internship period and academic calendar in view of ongoing Corona pandemic.

RGNUL COVID-19 Committee in its previous meetings prepared the academic calendar, and accordingly date sheet of end term examination was prepared. However, representations have been received from students to synchronize examination date sheet with other professional examination like CS Exams. Further, students have represented that they be allowed internship of four weeks. Accordingly, Committee deliberated upon all matters and after thoughtful deliberation, Committee resolved as under:

- 1. Open-Book Online Examination The End Term examinations along with reappear examination proposed to schedule from 31.12.2020 be revised to facilitate the students request. Accordingly, the re-appear examination be clubbed with the examination to be conducted for 1st semesters of UG & PG courses in the month of January and the examination of 3rd, 5th, 7th and 9th semesters should be conducted from 2nd January 2021 to 8th January 2021 to provide sufficient time for internship.
- 2. Preparatory Leave As the examinations are scheduled regularly (without break) the students should be provided sufficient time for preparation, therefore preparatory leave for End Term examination to all the students should be given from 25.12.2020 to 31.12.2020, however the students may contact the subject teachers for any clarifications regarding concerned subjects during this period.



- 3. Internship Period The internship break for 2nd year, 3rd year, 4th year and 5th students shall be from 9th January to 7th February 2021 i.e. four week internship break.
- 4. End -Term examination issues The examination branch has received some of the grievances of the students and also observations of the teachers evaluating the answer scripts. The issues related to End Term Examination of intermediate batches completed on 4.12.2020 shall be referred to a sub-committee to decide the issues on case-to-case basis and submit the recommendation before declaration of result.
- 5. Winter Brake University shall have winter break from 25th December to 31st December, 2020.
