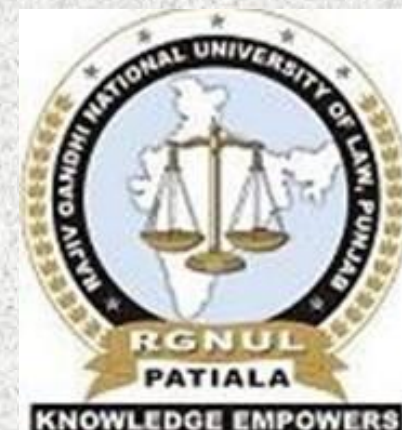

1. Eligibility

3. Guidelines for Submission

Authorship and Registration

- ❖ In the competition, co-authorship is permitted. However, the co-author has to register separately.
- ❖ No individual will be the author of more than one Paper. If any individual authors more than one Paper, then all such Papers will be disqualified.
- ❖ Only original Papers will be considered for the Competition. No part of it should have been published earlier and it should not be under consideration for publication or a contest elsewhere. Any form of plagiarism will result in disqualification of Paper.
- ❖ The Paper should not contain any Identification Mark of any sort.
- ❖ Registration Form and Declaration Form are to be sent along with the Paper. The Registration Form must be signed by the Head of the Institution/University. (The forms are available on the RGNUL website- www.rgnul.ac.in)

Research Paper Format

- ❖ The Research Paper must be written in English.
- ❖ The Research Paper should be typed in Times New Roman, Font Size 12 with line spacing of 1.5.
- ❖ The footnotes must be in Times New Roman, font size 10 and line spacing of 1.
- ❖ Footnotes must preferably conform to the Bluebook system of citation (19th edition) or any other uniform citation system.

Length of the Research Paper

- ❖ The Research Paper should include an abstract not exceeding 500 words mentioning the title and the keywords.
- ❖ The prescribed word limit for the Research Paper should be 3000-5000 words (exclusive of footnotes).
- ❖ Word Count is required to be mentioned on the Cover Page.
- ❖ The Research Paper can be sent in '.doc' or '.docx' format. (Strictly not in .pdf).

Electronic Submission

- ❖ The participant should E-mail the following attachments: Cover Page, Research Paper, Registration Form and Declaration Form.

4. Prizes

Best Research Paper- INR 15,000/-

Second Best Research Paper- INR 10,000/-

Third Best Research Paper- INR 5,000/-

The name of the winner will be displayed on the RGNUL website. Separate intimation will also be provided to all the winners.

The winners will be given the prizes on the Prize Distribution function, the exact date and location of which shall be announced later.

Certificate of Participation will be awarded to all participants.

5. Jury and Review Criteria

- ❖ Entries will be reviewed by a distinguished panel of impartial judges and academicians.
