# **ELIGIBILITY:**

The Journal invites submissions from legal academicians, practitioners, consultants, doctoral students, research scholars including inter-disciplinary scholars and law students affiliated with any institution within or outside India.

### **SUBMISSION CATEGORY:**

• Short Article: 4000-6000 words

• Long Article: 6000-10000 words

• Legislative Analysis: 2000-4000 words

• Case Comments: 3000-5000 words

<u>Note:</u> The prescribed word limits are exclusive of footnotes. However, the Editorial Board reserves the right to extend the word limit, in case the topic demands.

### **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:**

- All submissions must be made in English language only.
- Co-authorship is allowed upto a maximum of 2 authors.
- <u>Abstract:</u> All submissions should be accompanied by an abstract not exceeding 300 words outlining the central theme(s), within the submitted manuscripts.
- <u>Submission:</u> The article should be the original and unpublished work of the author(s) and any form of plagiarism is strictly prohibited. The contributor(s) has to give a declaration as to the originality of the work.
- Author(s) shall solely be responsible for the accuracy of statements, opinion and views presented in the manuscripts.
- The author(s) shall refrain from submitting the manuscript elsewhere during the pendency of the review process.
- The name(s) of the author(s) or his/her institutional affiliation or any other information must not be mentioned anywhere in the body of the submission.
- The Journal encourages gender neutrality in its submissions.

- **Format:** All submissions must be in Times New Roman, font size 12, justified and with 1.5 line spacing.
- Electronic submissions must be made in Word Format (.doc)/(.docx) only. Submissions made in any other format shall not be considered.
- <u>Citation Style:</u> All citations must be in conformity with *The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation (20th Ed.)*. All footnotes must be in Font 'Times New Roman', font size 10, line spacing 1, and justified.
- <u>Copyright:</u> The copyright in all the contributions presented to and accepted for
  publication shall vest in the owner of the RGNUL Journal on Contemporary Laws.
  However, in certain exceptional circumstances, the contribution including the table,
  graphs, charts etc. could be published elsewhere with the prior written permission of
  the Journal.
- <u>Indemnification:</u> The contributor(s) shall be solely responsible for any claim, suits, and damages for any copyright infringement, defamation, or contempt and agree to indemnify the Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law and RGNUL Journal of Contemporary Laws to suffer any losses if caused by the above-mentioned violation.
