Punjab University, Maharaja Bhupinder Singh Punjab Sports University, Jagat Guru Nanak Dev Punjab State Open University, Chitkara University and the Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Patiala, held a discussion on new vision for higher education research and pedagogy. RGNUL Vice-Chancellor GS Bajpai discussed the need to balance accessible higher education with aspirations of educational excellence. He emphasised on holistic combination of research and said, "Higher Education is entirely punctuated by classroom teaching with little focus on research", and highlighted inadequacy of funds for research and absence of capacity to research. He said, "Refresher courses and faculty development programmes are not facilitating the development of competencies", and underlined the importance of infusing critical thinking abilities. Prof Arvind, Vice-Chancellor, Punjab University, discussed the mandate to teach, research and engage in pursuit of eminence. He said academic programmes should be redesigned for the need of a student-centric curriculum. "Multi-disciplinary and interdisciplinary initiatives not only enhance the skills of learners, but also connect them with cultures. In research, quality matters over quantity," he remarked. Lt Gen Jagbir Singh Cheema, Vice-Chancellor, Maharaja Bhupinder Singh Punjab Sports University, discussed the trends in the sports industry and job avenues available to students. He apprised the audience about the state training centre available in the university for sportspersons.</p>

This discussion is a part of RGNUL Faculty Discourses initiated by Prof. G.S. Bajpai, Vice-Chancellor, RGNUL, Punjab (in the month of February). This discussion forum aims to provide RGNUL faculty an opportunity to benefit from in-person exchange of ideas on diverse dimensions of varied disciplines.</p> <p>Also Read - "What They Don't Teach You At Law School?": Dharmashastra National Law University Holds Workshop</p> <p>Mr. Sachin Sharma, Assistant Professor of Law, outlined the discursive truths surrounding disability, culture and gender through discussion on denial of sexual autonomy to persons with disabilities. 'Socio-medical discourses focusing on the disabled people tend to subjugate, degender and asexualize the First Person Discourses,' he said. Alluding to Franklin Miller's <i>Ethics of Consent</i>, Neil Manson's <i>Rethinking Informed Consent</i> and Ngozi Adichie's <i>Danger of Single Story</i>, Mr. Sharma highlighted on the fixed binaries and dual identities. Reflecting on the hegemonic culture and civil society model of social contract, he spoke about the third person dominance in disability-sexuality discourse. While talking about sexual personhood and law, Mr. Sharma emphasized that people with disability should be included in law-making processes. "Though the public discourse on sex and disability focusses on protection of vulnerable population from abuse, there is a need to recognize the inherent sexuality of disabled persons. In the times of capitalist bourgeois counter narratives should be voiced," he said. He also expanded on the processes of normalization and institutionalization that silence the voices of the disabled.</p> <p>Also Read - HNU Conclave On Constitutional Day 2022</p> <p>Prof. Anand Pawar, Registrar, RGNUL said, "This sensitive issue necessitates clear understanding of personal and systemic approaches that go beyond bio-medical approaches to meaningfully address disability-sexuality." Dr. Sidharth Dahiya, Deputy Registrar; Dr. Naresh Kumar Vats, Dean Academics & DSW; Dr. Sharanjit, Controller of Examination and RGNUL Faculty members were present during the discussion.</p>

4.	16-07-2022	<p>RGNUL features prominently in the Consumer Ministry Committee to Develop Framework on 'Right to Repair'</p> <p>RGNUL/PRO/2022/87</p>	<div> <div>  <p>Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution</p> </div> <div> <p>Department of Consumer Affairs sets up committee to develop comprehensive framework on the Right to Repair</p> <p>Farming Equipment, Mobile Phones/ Tablets, Consumer Durables and Automobiles/Automobile Equipment among sectors identified for right to repair in the 1st meeting of committee</p> <p>Right to repair to generate employment through Aatmanirbhar Bharat by allowing third-party and self-repairing of products</p> <p>Framework to be in synchronization with call for global initiative of LIFE movement by the Hon'ble Prime Minister</p> <p>Posted On: 14 JUL 2022 11:51AM by PIB Delhi</p> <p>In a bid to emphasize on LIFE (Lifestyle for the Environment) movement through sustainable consumption, the Department of Consumer Affairs has taken a significant step for developing an overall framework for the Right to Repair.</p> <p>The aim of developing a framework on right to repair in India is to empower consumers and product buyers in the local market, harmonize trade between the original equipment manufacturers and the third-party buyers and sellers, emphasize on developing sustainable consumption of products and reduction in e-waste. Once it is rolled out in India, it will become a game-changer both for the sustainability of the products and as well as serve as a catalyst for employment generation through Aatmanirbhar Bharat by allowing third-party repairs.</p> <p>The Department in this regard, has set up a committee which shall be chaired by Smt. Nidhi Khare, Additional Secretary, Department of Consumer Affairs, Government of India. The committee includes Shri Anupam Mishra, Joint Secretary DoCA, Justice Paramjeet Singh Dhaliwal, former Judge of Punjab and Haryana High Court, Former President of State Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission, Punjab, Prof. (Dr.) G.S. Bajpai Vice-Chancellor, Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Patiala, Prof. Shri Ashok Puri, Chair of Consumer Law and Practice and representatives from various stakeholders like ICEA, SIAM, Consumer Activists & Consumer Organizations as members.</p> <p>The committee held its first meeting on 13th July, 2022 wherein important sectors for right to repair were identified. The sectors identified include Farming Equipment, Mobile Phones/ Tablets, Consumer Durables and Automobiles/Automobile Equipment.</p> <p>The pertinent issues highlighted during the meeting include companies avoid the publication of manuals that can help users make repairs easily. Manufacturers have proprietary control over spare parts (regarding the kind of design they use for screws and other). Monopoly on repair processes infringes the customer's "right to choose". Digital warranty cards, for instance, ensure that by getting a product from a "non-recognized" outlet, a customer loses the right to claim a warranty. Controversy Surrounding Digital Rights Management (DRM) and Technological Protection Measure (TPM), DRM is a great relief for copyright holders. Manufacturers are encouraging a culture of "planned obsolescence". This is a system whereby the design of any gadget is such that it lasts a particular time only and after that particular period it has to be mandatorily replaced. When contracts fail to code fall control to the buyer-the legal right of owners are damaged.</p> <p>During the deliberations, it was felt that the tech companies should provide complete knowledge and access to manuals, schematics, and software updates and to which the software licenses shouldn't limit the transparency of the product in sale. The parts and tools to service devices, including diagnostic tools should be made available to third parties, including individuals so that the product can be repaired if there are minor glitches. Fortunately, in our country, there exists a vibrant repair service sector and third party repairs, including those who cannibalize the products for providing spare parts for circular economy.</p> <p>Further, the international best practices, steps that have been taken by other countries and how the same could be included in the Indian scenario were also discussed in the meeting. The right to repair has been recognized in many countries across the globe, including the U.S.A, U.K and European Union. In USA, the Federal Trade Commission has directed manufacturers to remedy unfair anti-competitive practices and asked them to make sure that consumers can make repairs, either themselves or by a third-party agency.</p> <p>Recently, the U.K has also passed a law that includes all the electronic appliance manufacturers to provide the consumers with spare parts for getting the repair done either by themselves or by the local repair shops. In Australia, repair cafes are a remarkable feature of the Australian system. These are free meeting places where volunteer repairmen gather to share their repairing skills. Further, the European Union passed legislation that required manufacturers to supply parts of products to professional repairmen for a time of 10 years.</p> <p>Last month, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi launched the concept of LIFE movement (Lifestyle for Environment) in India. This includes the concept of reuse and recycling various consumer products. Repair is a critical function of all forms of re-use and even for the sustainable life of the products. A product that cannot be repaired or falls under planned obsolescence i.e. designing a product with an artificially limited useful life, not only becomes e-waste but also forces the consumers to buy new products for want of any repair to reuse it. Thus, restricting the repair of products forces consumers to deliberately make a choice to purchase a new model of that product.</p> <p>The LIFE movement calls for mindful and deliberate utilization of product. The rationale behind the "Right to Repair" is that when we buy a product, it is inherent that we must own it completely for which the consumers should be able to repair and modify the product with ease and at reasonable cost, without being captive to the whims of manufacturers for repairs. However, over a period of time it has been observed that the Right to Repair is getting severely restricted, and not only there is a considerable delay in repair but at times the products are repaired at an exorbitantly high price and the consumer who has once bought the product is hardly given any choice.
