General Instructions for Newly Admitted Students B.A. LL.B. (Hons.) & LL.M. Programmes Academic Session 2026–27

Dear Students,

Welcome to the RGNUL family. We are delighted to have you join us and look forward to meeting you on campus. Kindly read the following instructions carefully before reporting to the University.

1. Reporting to the University

- Students may report to the University between **23rd and 24th July, 2026**.
- Hostel accommodation will be allotted upon arrival, and students may occupy their allotted rooms immediately after completing the reporting formalities.

2. Orientation Programme

- The Orientation Programme will be held on **Saturday, 25th July 2026**.
- All students must report by **9:30 a.m.** at the designated venue (University Auditorium).
- Attendance at the Orientation Programme is compulsory.
- Parents and guardians are cordially invited to attend the Orientation Programme, followed by lunch.

3. Commencement of Classes

- Classes will commence from **Monday, following the Orientation Programme**.
- The first week shall be observed as the **Orientation Week**, after which regular academic classes will begin.
- Students are advised to bring all necessary belongings and luggage while reporting, as they will begin residing on campus immediately.

4. Dress Code

Students are required to attend the Orientation Programme in the prescribed Uniform.

- White formal shirt
- Black formal trousers
- White kurta or white formal top/shirt
- Black salwar/trousers

The University uniform shall ordinarily be worn on:

- Every **Tuesday and Friday**
- Viva examinations
- Moot Courts
- Court visits
- University ceremonies and official events
- Any other occasion as notified by the University.



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5. Verification of Documents

Verification of original documents shall **not** take place during reporting. A separate schedule for document verification shall be notified after the commencement of classes. Students should carry all original documents safely for verification whenever scheduled.

6. Hostel Accommodation

- Hostel rooms shall be allotted upon reporting.
- Students are expected to occupy only the rooms allotted to them by the University.
- Any request for change of room shall be considered strictly as per University rules.

7. Guest House

Students are ordinarily expected to stay in their allotted hostel rooms. Parents or accompanying family members who wish to stay at the University Guest House may book accommodation, subject to availability, by writing to: guesthouse@rgnul.ac.in

8. Campus Facilities

The University has a **Facility Area** within the campus where students may purchase essential items required for hostel life, including:

- Mattresses
- Pillows
- Buckets
- Basic stationery
- Daily-use items
- Other essential supplies

These items are available in different price ranges for the convenience of students.

9. Communication

Students are advised to:

- Regularly check the University website for notices and announcements.
- Read all official emails and messages carefully.
- Report to the University on the scheduled dates only.
- Maintain discipline and decorum from the very first day.
- Follow all instructions issued by the University authorities.
- Treat fellow students, faculty members, staff and campus property with respect.
