Brindpreet Kaur, master of the ceremony, stressed that under the guidance of Prof Anand Pawar, vice-chancellor (RGNUL), and convenor, Manoj Kumar Sharma, associate professor of Law at RGNUL, the seminar provided a platform for robust discussions and insights into the challenges faced by the elderly. Manoj Kumar Sharma introduced the theme of the seminar. He highlighted the increasing population of elderly people in India, which is expected to reach 319 million by 2050 and the problems associated with it. 


