## 1. About the CCV

The Centre for Criminology, Criminal Justice and Victimology (CCV) has been established under the able leadership of Prof. (Dr.) G. S. Bajpai, Vice-Chancellor of RGNUL, Punjab to provide necessitated focus towards applied research on the evolving aspects of the transformative criminal justice system including the dimensions of victimology and criminology as particular areas of interest.

## 2. Agendas of Town Hall Meeting

1. Scope and objective of research in the areas of Criminology, Victimology, and Criminal Justice and how it can help in understanding and analyzing the crime pattern in society.
2. Role of Centre for Criminology, Criminal Justice and Victimology in assisting and facilitating the law enforcement agencies, the bench, the bar and the academic institutions, by venturing into unexplored areas or lesser intruded aspects of the criminal justice administration.
3. Need of studying and investigating the role of victims in an adversarial system in order to provide effective justice to the victims, by indulging in research to promote victim participation in criminal justice system.
4. Relevancy of conducting legal research in promoting academic discourse as well as literature and its contribution in developing legal doctrine.
5. Focusing on choosing the right research methodology and incorporating the basis of conducting an empirical research with special emphasis on inter-disciplinary approach for the better understanding of socio-legal offenses.
6. Steps to be taken in encouraging the culture of research in law schools and how to make it useful for the society as a whole. Moreover, how law students can contribute in academic research and their role in promoting the discourse.

## 3. Eligibility

Students of all the present batches of RGNUL, Law students from all other recognized universities, CCV Members, CCV Faculty Coordinators and CCV Volunteers shall be allowed to partake in the meeting.
