REPORT: ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION 2021

The Centre for Advanced Studies in Criminal Law (CASCL), RGNUL successfully organised an essay writing competition on the theme '**Exploring Gender Justice: The Laws and the Lacunae**' in the month of November, 2021.

The objective of the competitions was to help participants develop better reading, writing and research skills and at the same time help them inculcate creativity and passion for writing.

It also provided a platform to the young participants to bring forth their possibly hidden potential in writing as well as helped furthering their knowledge about Gender Justice.
