INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. Candidates should take their seats 20 minutes before the commencement of Examination.
2. **No student shall be allowed to enter the Examination Hall without Identity Card and Admit Card.** Show your Identity Card and Admit Card at the entrance of the academic block and to the Invigilator for verification whenever desired by the Invigilators.
3. **The Answer Sheet contains 36 pages (Please check before using). No part of the Answer sheet is to be torn out.**
4. Every candidate should write his/her Roll Number on the top of Question paper.
5. The candidate should not write anything else on his/her Question paper, except Roll Number.
6. **Disclosing Identity in any form on the Answer Sheet shall be treated as 'Unfair Means' and shall be dealt with as per the University Rules.**
7. Every candidate should ensure that he/she has received the correct Question Paper.
8. Write Question No. and its part before attempting the answers. Use the same number for the answer as is given in the Question Paper.
9. The whole work including the rough work is to be written in the Answer Sheet. However, rough work is to be scored out.
10. No student shall be allowed to borrow Bare Act, pen, pencil, eraser, scales etc. from other students.
11. **No student shall use other than blue pen in the examination.** Use of pencil is permitted if required in specific subjects. **Use of Highlighter/Marker is prohibited.**
12. No student shall be allowed to carry **Bag, Smart/digital watch (including fit bit), Mobile-Phone, Pager, Laptop and any other electronic gadget** etc. inside the Examination Hall.
13. Candidates found copying / exchanging answer sheets / using any unfair means / found in possession of any unauthorized paper of any kind or note-book in the Examination Hall shall be dealt with as per the University Rules pertaining to unfair means.
14. No supplementary answer sheet shall be provided.
15. During the examination no student shall be allowed to use washroom except in emergency with permission of the Invigilator. No student shall be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before half time.
16. Candidates must stop writing when instructed to do so by the officer or invigilator of the University after the expiry of the permitted time and give their Answer Sheets to the Deputy Supdt./Centre Supdt. in their room. No student should leave the Answer Sheet on the table.
17. Any disturbance by the candidate / non-compliance of the instructions given by the Centre-Superintendent/ Deputy Superintendent shall be taken as misconduct and dealt with as per University rules.
