"the salaries of the regular teachers shall be as per the UGC pay scales as notified by the University Grants Commission from time to time."

The Finance Committee unanimously resolved that:

- (i) the implementation of pay scales of teachers as per the UGC 7th Pay Commission is allowed with immediate effect.
- (ii) however, the salary expenditure be met out of the University resources till the State Govt. notifies and release the grant.
- (iii) Viability of payment of arrears shall be assessed by the university depending its financial status and other relevant factors including the notification of State of Punjab in this regard.
- (iv) The Hon'ble Member Mr. Mohit Tewari, IRS, Special Secretary to Finance, also advised that the consolidated proposal for capital and maintenance grant (2022-23) as proposed may be resubmitted to the Govt. of Punjab.
