## **AGAHI ADJUDICATOR SUBSIDY RULES**

These rules will be hereby referred to as the RGNUL adjudicator subsidy rules and must be conformed to whilst providing subsidy to any adjudicator for this very edition of Agahi.

- 1. For the purpose of the rules the following shall mean:
- a. *Independent adjudicator*: The adjudicator shall not be a part of any competing team or be coming through the 'n+1' formulae.
- b. Website: Shall mean the designated website for the Agahi '18 competition.
- c. Subsidy: See clause 6 for the same.
- 2. For the purposes of subsidy it is required that independent adjudicators apply in the web-link in the relevant form for consideration.
- 3. The application must have relevant adjudicating and debating credentials along.
- 4. The adjudicators with the maximum marks will be considered for given subsidy.
- 5. The marking criteria for judging the score of each applicant will be as follows:
- a. Best adjudicator: 10 points
- b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Best Adjudicator: 7 points
- c. Breaking adjudicator: 5 points
- d. Best team: 7 points
- e. Best speaker: 5 points
- f. Runners Up team: 3 points
- g. 2<sup>nd</sup> best speaker:3 points
- 6. The total points for each candidate shall be the addition of points earned through every achievement.
- 7. The subsidy shall be consisting of the following:
- a. Waiver of registration fees.
- b. Travel Allowance from Delhi to Patiala (Bus communication).
- 8. Candidates will be required to present a true / copy of the ticket they used for traveling.
- 9. Deadline for application: 15 September 2019.
- 10. Successful candidates will be selected by: Agahi Core Committee.
