	Ministry of Education, Government of India has recently launched the scheme of Academic Bank of Credits (ABC), with the aim to enable students mobility across Higher Education Institution, seamless, integration of skills and experiences into a Credit Based System. It has been established on the lines of National Academic Depository (NAD). ABC enables students to register or commence credit transfer, the final outcomes of credit redemption and issuance of certificates, as well as the compilation of awards records. RGNUL has registered on the ABC portal for uploading data of RGNUL students, however, the process for transfer of Credits is required to be laid down keeping in view the extra credit course scheme and choice based credit systems and the mandate of the New Education Policy. There is a need to adopt, adapt and implementation the ABC at RGNUL and to discuss the modalities for its adoption.	During the discussion the members were apprised that the RGNUL has already been registered for the Academic Bank of Credits, on the Government Portal. Members were of the opinion that detailed rules for transfer of credits are required to be laid down after detailed examination of the UGC regulations. Further, members were also of the view that the credit courses run by RGNUL should also be registered on the ABC portal.	Keeping in view, the complicated nature of the matter, members decided to authorize the Chairperson to constitute a Committee for making recommendations to the IQAC. 
