ETHICS POLICY FOR RGNUL PUBLICATIONS

- Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law (RGNUL), Punjab, was established by the State Legislature of Punjab in 2006 (Punjab Act No. 12 of 2006). The Act incorporated a University of Law a National Statue in the State of Punjab.
- The University ventured into publication in 2011 with its premier Law Journal; RGNUL Law Review (RLR). With this a comprehensive ethics policy for all the publications and research work to be undertaken by the faculty, staff and students of RGNUL was adopted.
- 3. The Journals presently being published by Registrar, RGNUL include RGNUL Law Review (RLR), RGNUL Social Sciences Journal (RSSJ), CASHIRJournal of Human Rights, RFMLR, Student Law Review aims at providing a forum for sharing advanced research and scholarship. They are unique Pear Review publicationswhich are providing comprehensive coverage to some of the important and contemporary legal issues motivating the minds of jurists at the National and International levels. Our chief objective is to reflect the contemporary trends in legal thinking that could be applied for giving shape to the future policies and programmes for betterment of the society.
- 4. The publications of RGNUL maintain the dignity of the Author(s) and their work and honor their sincerity towards research. Almost every step in the publication process involves ethical principles related to research work. These journals are peer reviewed journals and the Editors adhere to the submission process, blind peer review process, intimations to authors, removal of errors and mistakes etc. The publications are strictly against data fabrication and falsification. The Editorial Board takes a very serious note of text duplication, duplicate submission, authorship concerns, fabricated research results and the decision of the board; and the University Authorities regarding such matters is final and duly intimated to the concerned writer. Written record of all the communications is maintained by the editor(s).
- 6. Each publication(s) duly notifies the call for papers/blogs alongwith the guidelines for publication, acceptance of publication, decision of peer review board/members and acceptance/review/rejection of the article to the Author.
- 7. No publication of RGNUL seeks or offers publications based upon any form of remuneration from the Author(s).
